Heifer Show will be **BLOW & SHOW** only, No adhesives or paint can be used.

EXHIBITION CONDITIONS:

- 1. All entries in the Junior Breeding Heifer Show shall be subject to the General Rules and Regulations and to the special rules of the Junior Livestock Show. All Heifers must have been recorded through the Texas 4-H and FFA Heifer Validation and in the exhibitors name by Nov 1, 2016.
- 2. **ELIGIBILITY:** The Junior Hereford and Polled Hereford Heifer show is limited to entries from the state of Texas. To be eligible, exhibitors must be in the third grade or nine years old and no more than nineteen years old by or on September 1, 2016. They must be enrolled in a private or public elementary or secondary school of Texas (accredited home schools are accepted) and be a bona fide resident of Texas during the show dates and proper ownership periods. Exhibitors must have continuously and personally fed and cared for the animals under direct supervision of a County Extension Agent or Agriculture Science Teacher.

EACH EXHIBITOR WILL HAVE TO PROVIDE A "QUALITY COUNTS" VERIFICATON NUMBER WITH ENTRIES. (Number to be provided on the summary sheet sent in by County Agent or Ag Teacher.)

- 3. **HEALTH PAPERS are NOT required for Heifers to Show.
- 4. There is no limit to the number of heifers shown by one exhibitor
- 5. The heifers must have been recorded in the registry of the American Hereford Association in the name of the exhibitor by November 1, 2016. Exhibitors must have the original registration certificate for each animal available for inspection at Heifer check in beginning at 1 PM on Thursday, January 5th, 2017. No Photocopies, facsimiles, phone calls, emails or letters in place of the original registration certificate.
- 6. All Entries must be exhibited by the owners, except when an exhibitor has more than one entry in one class or cannot be present to show the animal due to medical condition. In these

- cases, any other 4-H member or Vocational Agriculture student taking part in this show may exhibit the animal.
- 7. *****NEW All entries must be postmarked by November 15, 2016. There will be a \$35.00 entry fee charged for each heifer. Tie outs will be available at the time of entry to \$10 each. There will be no refunds on entry fees. Entries postmarked between November 16 and December 1, 2016 will be accepted but accessed a \$100 late fee.
- 8. All cattle will be bedded on sand, no straw or hay may be used in the barns for bedding material. Shavings will be allowed to be put on top of the sand per facility manager.
- 9. ARRIVAL TIME: No arrivals before 12 noon Wednesday, January 4, 2017. Must be in the barn by 12 noon Thursday, January 5, 2017.
- 10. The Supreme Champion, Reserve Supreme Champion, Both Breed Champions and Reserve Breed Champions, Junior and Senior Showmanship exhibitors will be asked to present their heifers in the Parade of Champions at the Sandhills Rodeo on Friday Evening, January 6, 2017.
- 11. Heifers will be divided into classes according to the listed schedule. Show Management reserves the right to make adjustments to the schedule based on entries.
- 12. Heifers will be divided into breeds, Horned Hereford Heifer Classes will begin at 1 PM on Friday, January 6, 2017 followed by the Polled Hereford Heifer Classes, followed by Supreme Champion Heifer Drive, and then Heifer Showmanship.
- 13. **Showmanship Ages:** The Heifer Showmanship contest will be judged immediately following the completion of the Supreme Heifer Drive and all showmen are invited to compete. There are two age divisions: Junior: Age 13 and under as of January 1, 2017 and Senior: Age 14 and up as of January 1, 2017.
- 14. Exhibitors may not tie out in the West covered arena.
- 15. One fan will be permitted for each three animals.
- 16. Any un-sportsman like conduct, such as interfering with the judges, etc. will bar the exhibitor from the present and future shows. The decision of the judge is final and is not able to be protested.
- 17. All protests must be in writing and accompanied by \$250.00. Money will be refunded if protest is sustained. Such protests must plainly state the cause of the complaint or appeal and must be presented prior to judging of classes. The Executive Committee of the Sandhills Stock Show reserves the right to interpret these rules and arbitrarily settle and determine all matters, questions and differences arising from any protest.

NO PROTEST WILL BE ALLOWED ON OFFICIAL PLACINGS.
